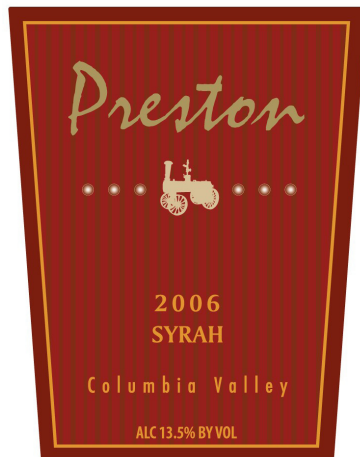

Winemaking & Vintage...

2006 was another favorable year for growing wine grapes in Washington State. Spring conditions were dry, leading to a beautiful fruit set. Summer temperatures were a little warmer than normal but rainfall was below average, resulting in slow ripening. Even September temperatures led to full ripe and robust flavors. Fermented on a combination of custom yeasts, this Syrah was aged in French, Hungarian, and American oak barrels (50% new and 50% between two and three years old).

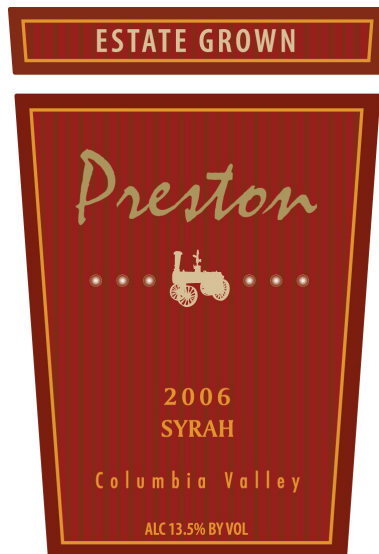

A Family Tradition Continues...

- Our family is a pioneer in the Washington Wine Industry.
- Established in 1976, with the first vines dating back to 1972, we became the third licensed winery in the state.
- Family traditions continue today, as we remain one of the few wineries in Washington State still family owned and now operated by second and third generations.
- Presently, Brent Preston oversees operations, while his daughter Chenyn Preston-Johnson manages the tasting room and special events.
- Winery grounds (available for rental) include an amphitheater, small manicured park which is great for picnicking, a pond, gorgeous waterfall, and a gazebo perfect for all types of outdoor receptions/weddings.
- For smaller gatherings, such as private parties or dinners, corporate events or private tastings, the tasting room and deck are another alternative and hold approximately 100 guests.
- Inside the winery you will find a large tasting room and gift shop with specialty items, and a self-guided tour with a variety of displays, like one of the largest corkscrew collections.
- The large deck overlooks the first 50 acres of vineyards planted and is the perfect place to relax and watch the sunset over the Columbia Valley with views of Rattlesnake Mountain.
- Our wines are all Estate Grown, and include both white and red varieties: Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Gamay Noir, White Riesling, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Syrah.
- The tasting room also carries an extensive library selection of port wines.
